ADMISSION ASSESSMENT:

- All students should bring a pen or pencil.
- Instrumentalists should bring their instruments and prepare one solo piece which best shows their talent and performance skills. Students may audition on any instrument. Students may audition on multiple instruments.
- Vocalists should prepare one solo piece which best shows their talent and performance skills.
- Students will also be judged on rhythmic and tonal aptitude.
- All auditions will be conducted **without accompaniment**. Pre-recorded material and live accompanists are not permitted.
- Students' academic and attendance records are also reviewed.
