

It's the Lunch Bunch!!!!

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

Bayside High School needs your help. Like all schools, we have experienced recent budget reductions and expect deeper ones in the near future. By completing and having your child submit the attached form, you are helping your child, our school, and the community to survive these uncertain times.

Tomorrow, your student will be asked to submit his/her lunch form when they arrive at school. As you can see, he/she has carefully filled out most of it and we request that you review and complete it as follows:

Section 1- Please skip and leave blank

Section 2- Please review the information your child has written- this should only be for your children who are attending Bayside High School- **not other schools.**

Section 3- If you receive Food Stamps or TANF- please fill this in; otherwise, please leave blank

Section 4- Please review the information your child has written. In the boxes next to each person's name, please write the approximate amounts asked for (Earnings; child support payments; pensions/social security payments received/ other income) and how often (weekly=W; every 2 weeks=E; monthly=M; yearly=Y). Please put "O" to indicate zero if the number is zero.

Section 5- Please sign the form in the box marked "X". Please provide one parent/caregiver's social security number or please leave blank and then write "NONE" in the boxes to the right of the social security boxes. Please review the other information provided by your child and return the form to him/her to bring to school tomorrow.

By submitting this form, your child:

- May be eligible to receive free or reduced price lunch
- May be eligible for **FREE** college testing (SAT/ACT); SAT prep; college application fees; and NCAA Clearinghouse Scholarship fees. This saves you between \$1500.00 to \$2000.00 in 11th/12th grade.
- Helps his class be eligible for prizes!
- May win a trip to Hawaii for your entire family!
- Helps Bayside High School get federal funding to offset City & State budget cuts

By not submitting this form, your child:

- May miss out on participating in after school activities & teams
- May have larger class sizes and less selection of courses next year
- May not have tutoring and extended day/Saturday classes available to him/her
