FREE SAT Practice Test

Saturday, March 20, 2010, 8:30 am

A practice test will be given at Bayside High School on Saturday, March 20, 2010, at 9:00 am (arrive by 8:30 am to check in). This is open to all students and is completely FREE. By taking a full-length practice test in real time, simulating the actual experience; students learn what an actual SAT test is like and learn what *taking* an SAT is really like. The practice test is timed and proctored, just like the real thing. Students get a detailed score report so they can identify their strengths and weaknesses and create an effective study plan. This test will serve only as a benchmark so students and parents can better understand the structure of the test and the types of questions to expect. **The scores will not be sent to any colleges.** Students should bring their own calculator to the test. Any type of calculator (4-function or graphing) is fine.

FREE Workshop by The Princeton Review

Students who take the practice SAT test will be able to attend a follow-up strategy session. At this workshop, students will meet an expert Princeton Review instructor who will walk them through some difficult test questions and explain what the SAT score results mean. Participants will learn more about the structure of the tests, types of questions to expect, and proven techniques. The Scores Back Session will be held at various locations throughout Queens.
