## Title One - Parent Involvement Survey

Dear Fellow Parents/Guardians:

The purpose of this survey is to help our Title One Committee prioritize our parent involvement activities and provide all Bayside families a final opportunity for feedback.

Due to recent changes in the Federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act, for the first time in Bayside History, we are eligible to receive supplemental Title One Funds. – It is mandatory that at least 1% of the overall funds be set aside for short-term parent involvement activities.

Reminders: (1) Title One Funding is not guaranteed yearly, so we must make every penny count while we have this opportunity. (2) The other 99% of the title one funds are currently being used by our school administrators to provide supplemental services to help the students directly.

Let Your Voices Be Heard: After our P.T.A. meeting on January 20, 2010, our Principals Annual Title 1 meeting was held and the Title One Committee, working with the parents and our school administrators made the following suggestions on how to spend the \$16,000, currently left in the special title one account.

Based on your top choices and what we can do within our budget and vendor guidelines, the top rated services will be provided March – June 2010.

The deadline to submit our purchase orders is approaching very soon. As a result, we are asking that you complete and submit this survey on or before close of business on **Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>**.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Social Worker Program Roundtable** - Social work programs in school and assistance for students/parents. Specific topics and behavior issues, SPARK program, etc.

### College & Career Services

\_\_\_\_\_ **College Application Process** - learn about your child's college application process. Fill out an application for SUNY's/CUNY's.

\_\_\_\_\_ **School Financial Aid** – step by step to fill out actual financial application (Fafsa) to save on file.

\_\_\_\_\_ **College Visit** – Bus trip visit to local (within bus travel distance) colleges for parents (and students).

\_\_\_\_\_ **Career Decisions for your Child** - Specialist come in and speak with parents on guiding their children through the career decision process.

### Parent Resource Service

\_\_\_\_\_ **Study Skill Workshop** - Show parents strategies and how to help their children develop good study habits and how to assist your child with school assignments/projects. Get first hand information on what teachers expect of your children's homework. "What's a rubric?"

\_\_\_\_\_ **Bayside High School Parent Handbook** - a resource for parents to guide them through their child's high school experience at Bayside. Parent Outreach and parent resource information. DOE Parent Rights, responsibilities.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Computer Training Workshop** - to access school website eChalk, and Daedalus, & NYC DOE website, ARIS, and ACUITY.

\_\_\_\_\_ **June Orientation** - for new students & parents (incoming 9th graders).

\_\_\_\_\_ **Internet Safety Seminar & Workshop** - Present the iSAFE "iParent" presentation to inform parents about internet safety and how to insure their children are using the internet safely. Parents will bring their issues and concerns and learn ways to address & respond to them.

A hands-on workshop will provide parents with computer user skills showing them what to be careful for on the internet, how to review the list of internet access history on their (children's) PC's. What safe practices to put in place to safeguard their children and computer. This addresses child predators, cyber bullying, identity theft, copy rights and intellectual property, plagiarism.
